Did you know that individuals caring for other families' children, more than 10 hours a week on a regular basis in on-base quarters, must be licensed by the installation commander?

#### The exceptions are:

1. Individuals who occasionally provide care for a friend or neighbor.
2. Teenagers doing evening or weekend babysitting for families in their parent's home.
3. Care provided in the parent's home.
4. Parent cooperatives where one of the parents provides supervision for other parents' children and no funds are provided.
5. Temporary full-time care of child during a parent's absence for temporary duty or deployment by the person listed on the AF Form 357, Family Care Plan.
